As outlined in Article 45 of the Constitution the positions eligible for nomination/election to the Board are...

- a) The Chair** who shall act as the chairperson of the Board (who shall be in addition to the Officers referred to in sub-paragraphs b) – f) below) and who shall be nominated by the Nominations Committee subject to the approval of the Company in general meeting.
- b) The Deputy Chair** who will be the vice-chairperson of the Board.
- c) The Secretary.**
- d) Two Member Representative Officers.**
- e) Two Member Officers** who shall be nominated by the Nominations Committee subject to the approval of the Company in general meeting.
- f) Two Independent Officers** who shall be nominated by the Nominations Committee subject to the approval of the Company in general meeting.

Please review in full the 'Board & Board Officer Role Description' document & associated 'GI Governance Brief' document to ensure you are fully aware of the nature of the role, the qualifications/experience required for the same and the process for appointment/election.


All nominated candidates will be assessed by the Nominations Panel against the criteria in the 'Board & Board Officer Role Description' document, only candidates who meet the criteria will be allowed to go forward for election by the members at the AGM or proceed to consideration/appointment by the Nominations Panel.

PLEASE NOTE:

- All term positions are for 3 years
- Independent Officers are defined as not being members nor shall they be a 'Connected Person'. 'Connected Person' means a spouse, parent, guardian, brother, sister or child of any member, employee of the Company or a person who has held an influential position within the Company within the past 3 years.
- No one person can occupy more than one place on the Board
- Nominations will only be accepted if both section 1 & 2 are fully completed and duly signed on this 'AGM Nomination Form'
- Candidates for election/nomination are requested to complete section 3 re endorsements of other candidates who are also going forward for election/nomination to the Board
