Logan Dooley is an American trampolinist and Olympic finalist who made history by qualifying for a world championship final in 2013, which an American male hadn't done in 33 years. His achievements include:

- 2017 U.S. synchro silver medalist
- Competed at the 2016 Olympic Games
- 2016 U.S. trampoline silver medalist
- Seven-time U.S. synchro champion (2007-10, 13-14, 16)
- Member of the 2007, 09, 10-11, 13-15 World Championships Teams
- 2015 U.S. trampoline silver medalist
- 2014 U.S. trampoline bronze medalist
- Advanced to the trampoline finals at the 2013 World Championships
- 2013 U.S. trampoline bronze medalist
- Alternate for the 2012 Olympic Games
- 2012 U.S. trampoline & synchro silver medalist
- 2011 U.S. trampoline silver medalist
- 2010 U.S. trampoline silver medalist
- Won the first World Cup Series synchro title for the U.S. in 2010
- Alternate for the 2008 Olympic Games
